ORDINANCES

The following Ordinances were passed by Hilliard City Council on October 26, 2015.

15-36 ENACTING CHAPTER 755 OF THE CITY'S CODIFIED ORDINANCES TO REGULATE MASSAGE AND BATH ESTABLISHMENTS IN HILLIARD.

WHEREAS, Council desires to place reasonable regulations upon those who desire to operate massage and bath establishments in the City, which establishments and employees are not regulated by Section 4731.15 of the Ohio Revised Code under the jurisdiction of the State Medical Board of Ohio (such as licensed massage therapists); and

WHEREAS, in order to regulate massage and bath establishments and employees performing those services in the City, Chapter 755 of the City's Codified Ordinances must be enacted; and

WHEREAS, if enacted, Chapter 755 will require those operating a massage or bath establishment to apply for and obtain a registration from the City's Chief of Police and will require masseuse and masseurs to apply for and obtain a registration from the City's Chief of Police in order to provide massage services at a registered massage or bath establishment in the City; and

WHEREAS, if enacted, Chapter 755 will permit the City to conduct inspections as necessary to enforce the provisions therein, including, but not limited to, prohibiting the employment of un-registered masseuses or masseurs; employing anyone under the age of eighteen; and failure to maintain facilities in a clean and sanitary condition, including providing sanitary towels and linens; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to penalize those establishments or persons that violate the provisions of Chapter 755 as misdemeanors of the first degree, as violations thereof are detrimental to the health, safety and welfare of the City's residents and to those that patron massage or bath establishments; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 755, as provided in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and incorporated herein, is needed to protect the health, safety, and welfare of the residents of Hilliard.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Hilliard, Ohio that:

SECTION 1. City Council finds that regulating massage and bath establishments is in the City's best interest and is needed for the health, safety and welfare of Hilliard residents. Chapter 755 of the Codified Ordinances of Hilliard, Ohio is enacted and shall hereafter read as identified in Exhibit "A" **attached** hereto and incorporated as if fully rewritten herein.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall be in effect from and after the earliest time provided for by law.

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ORDINANCES

15-37 AMENDING CHAPTER 971 OF THE CITY'S CODIFIED ORDINANCES REGARDING THE REGULATION OF PUBLIC PARKS IN HILLIARD.

WHEREAS, the City's Director of Recreation and Parks has deemed it advisable to review rules and regulations of the City's public parks codified in Chapter 971 of the City's Codified Ordinances; and

WHEREAS, the Director desires to clarify, modify, eliminate and add certain code provisions in Chapter 971 as identified in Exhibit "A", attached hereto and incorporated herein; and

WHEREAS, the Director desires to increase the penalty for violating certain code provisions from a minor misdemeanor to a misdemeanor of the fourth degree, including damage to park features, structures and equipment; disorderly conduct in a public park; use of alcohol or illicit drugs in a public park; and hunting or setting off explosive devices in a public park; and

WHEREAS, the City believes that adopting Chapter 971, as amended in Exhibit "A", promotes the general health, safety and welfare of the City and its residents.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Hilliard, Ohio that:

SECTION 1. Council finds that amending Chapter 921, **attached** hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein, regarding Public Parks, promotes the general health, safety and welfare of the City and its residents. Council adopts Chapter 921 as amended in Exhibit "A", with deletions to Chapter 921 being stricken and new language added identified in nonblack typeface.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance is effective from and after the earliest time provided for by law.

RESOLUTIONS

The following Resolution was adopted by Hilliard City Council on October 26, 2015.

15-R-71 A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE 2015 RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE TAX INCENTIVE REVIEW COUNCIL ("TIRC") FOR THE REVIEW OF COMMUNITY REINVESTMENT AREA AND TAX INCREMENT FINANCING PROJECTS.

WHEREAS, the City has Community Reinvestment Area ("CRA") Agreements and Tax Increment Financing ("TIF") projects in the City for purposes of economic development; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to R.C. 5709.85(A)(2) the City created a Tax Incentive Review Council (TIRC) to annually review all agreements granting exemptions from property taxation in CRAs and exemptions from property taxation resulting from the declaration of public purpose improvements pursuant to TIF exemptions (the CRA and TIFs collectively hereafter referred to as the "exemption projects"); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 5709.85 of the Ohio Revised Code, the City's TIRC must meet annually to review all exemption projects as to compliance with applicable statutes and agreements; and

WHEREAS, the City's TIRC held its annual public meeting on August 12, 2015 to review the exemption projects in the City, and after full discussion, voted to recommend the continuation of each exemption project; and

WHEREAS, by law, City Council must vote to accept, reject, or modify all or any portion of the TIRC recommendations.

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RESOLUTIONS

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hilliard, Ohio that:

SECTION 1. City Council accepts the recommendations of the Hilliard Tax Incentive Review Council to maintain the approved exemption projects identified in Exhibit "A" **attached** hereto and incorporated herein.

SECTION 2. The Clerk of Council shall forthwith send a certified copy of this Resolution to the Franklin County Auditor.

SECTION 3. This Resolution is effective upon adoption.
