

# Hilliard's Station Park

## Rules and Guidelines

The City of Hilliard has established the following rules and guidelines for your safe and enjoyable use of this facility. Those planning to use the facility are advised to follow these rules to ensure a safe and fun experience.

- Any use of this facility is at your own risk. The City of Hilliard does not assume responsibility for damages or injury.
- There is no lifeguard on duty.
- Hours of operation are from 8am-10pm.
- To ensure water safety for all, children not toilet trained must wear water proofed diapers. (*Swim Diapers*)
- All ages are welcome to use the park. Minors should be supervised by an adult.
- The following are not permitted in the park area: alcoholic beverages (unless it is during an event with an approved beer garden), smoking and other tobacco products, drugs, fighting, profanity, graffiti, tagging, metal or glass containers, bicycles, motorized vehicles, scooters, skate boards, hover boards, roller blades, portable pools, climbing on structures, no drinks with red dye.
- Please keep pets leashed and away from the water area.
- Certain weather conditions may create an unsafe environment for water play.
- All organized events require prior written approval from the City of Hilliard.
- The City of Hilliard reserves the right to close the facility without prior notice, for any circumstance deemed necessary.
- The City of Hilliard reserves the right to restrict entry to the facility and ask people to leave the facility if any of the rules are not followed or unsafe behavior is observed.

The use of water shoes is recommended.
